

THE STORY SO FAR...

In September of 2016, the Alabama Department of Public Health released a 17-page deficiency report for the facility of Planned Parenthood Birmingham. The report documented egregious failures that put every patient at risk. Some include:

- Failure to properly sterilize medical instruments.
- Failure to clean recovery chairs between patients.
- Failure to document fetal viability.
- Failure to ensure women viewed the ultrasound.
- Failure to ensure employees have not tested positive for Hep B or TB.

In response, the pro-life organization CEC For Life has teamed up with national orgs Operation Rescue, Americans United for Life, Christian Defense Coalition, as well as local Alabama groups, to call for the immediate shutdown of Planned Parenthood.

Aside from the most recent deficiencies, Planned Parenthood of Birmingham has a well-documented history of breaking state laws and endangering lives. Things like:

- Covering up statutory rape (2010).
- Employees selling abortion drugs illegally in the parking lot (2014).
- Failing to notify ADPH of random closures (2014).
- Performing an abortion on an empty uterus, resulting in a lawsuit (2012).

According to Rules of the Alabama State Board of Health, all of the things listed above are *ample* grounds for revoking Planned Parenthood's license *today* – not tomorrow.
